WARM FOLK

Tools: Cutting mat, rotary cutter, sewing machine, iron, pins
A small rotary cutter (size 28mm) is helpful for cutting curves.

Optional tools:

1/4 inch glue stick from Fons & Porter or Sewline

(regular school glue sticks are not precise enough even though the glue is a similar, sticky washable glue).

Materials:

Fabric requirements are based on 40" of usable fabric once selvages are removed. A coloring sheet is included on the second page to help with planning the fabric arrangement. Templates are included on the third page.

*****BE SURE YOU PRINT TEMPLATES AT ACTUAL SIZE.** Some printers scale to fit the page without being asked to. Use the 1 inch scale box to check that your printer is on the correct setting. If you prefer a thicker template, consider gluing template copies to thin cardboard (i.e. cereal box) and then cutting.

For the binding:

5 strips WOF per your desired width. Width of 2 1/4" requires 1/4 yard. Width of 2 1/2" (1/3 yard).

For the backing: 1 3/4 yard pieced to make a 51" x 51" square (3" inch overhang on each side).

For the top:

Fabric A – 1/2 yard

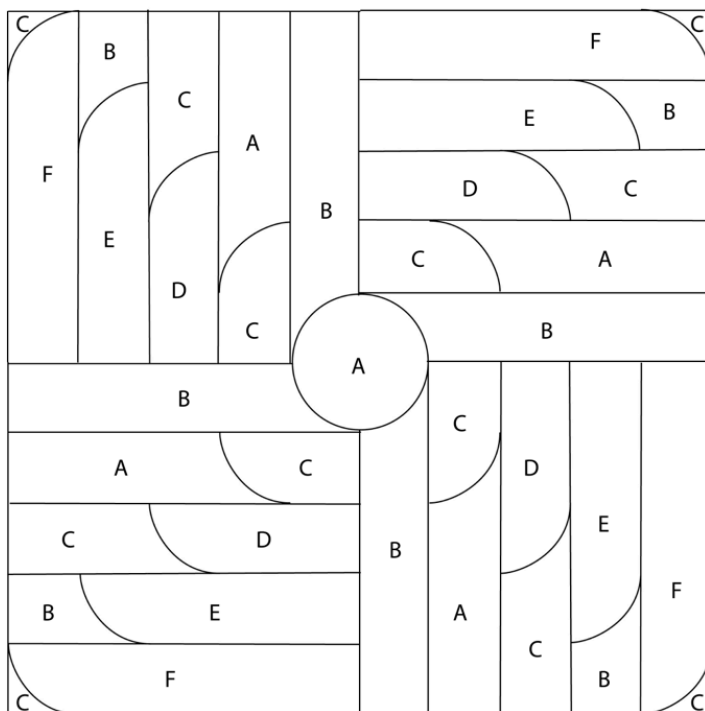
Fabric B – 2/3 yard

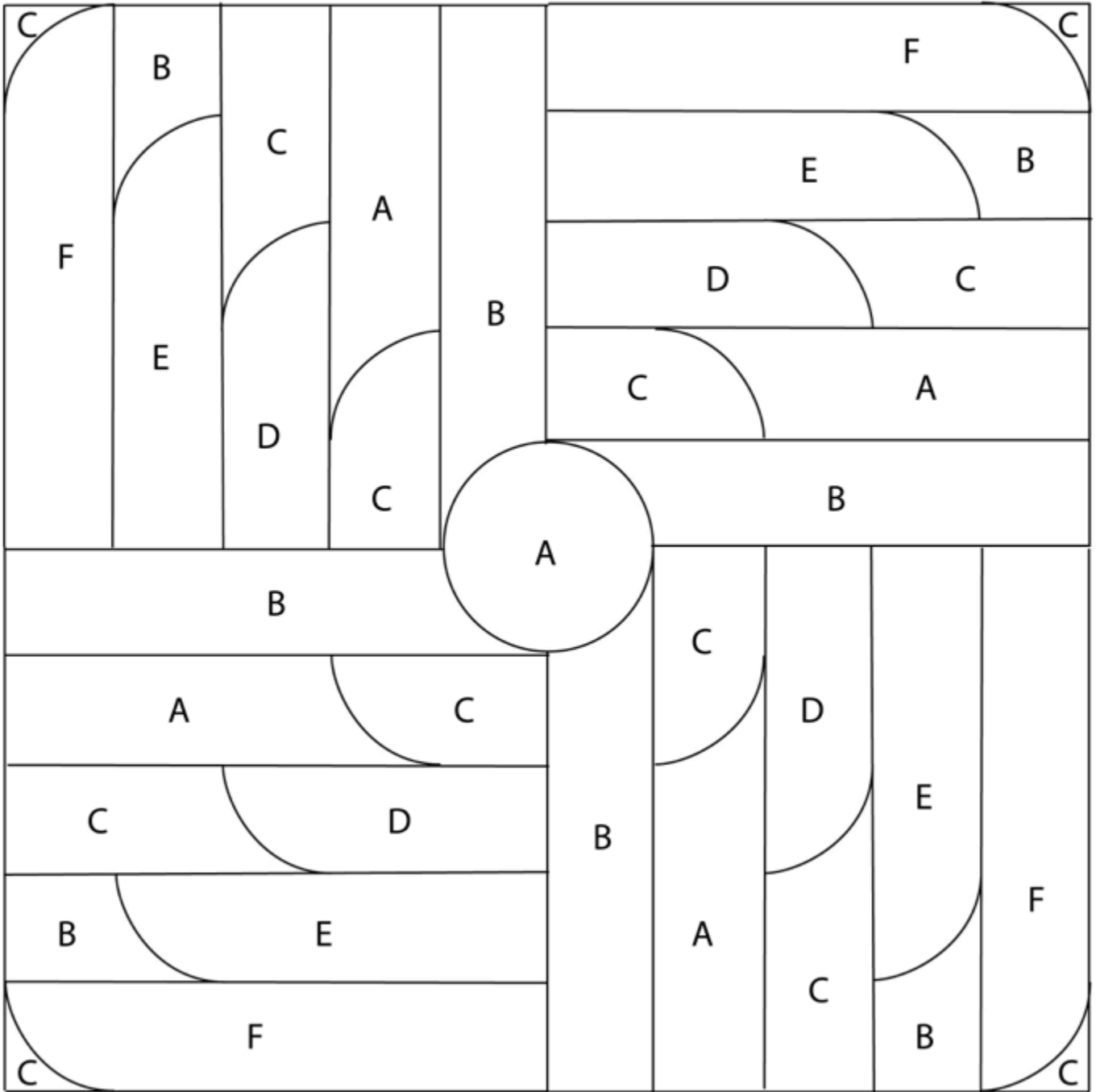
Fabric C – 1/2 yard

Fabric D – 1/3 yard

Fabric E – 1/3 yard

Fabric F – 1/2 yard
