

Bargello in the Round – Machine Class

In this class we will be making a spiral bargello using strip sets and cutting with the 10-degree wedge ruler. Finished project measures 42" in diameter.



Skill Level Required: The pattern calls for intermediate skill level. If you are a confident beginner, I think we can make it work!

Kit Fee: none /optional Printed and Marked template \$1 (advance orders only – see information below)

Supply List: Your Basic Sewing Supplies. ie: machine, pins, scissors, etc. A mat, rotary cutter, 24-inch ruler, 10-degree wedge ruler/template. Here is an option for a 10-degree acrylic ruler template on Amazon <https://a.co/d/aRSaZwE> .

Four 28" x 44" fabrics. Be sure to include a light, a dark and 2 in between fabrics for best contrast.

One additional 10" x 10" piece of one of the fabrics for the center

Pre-cut each fabric into 8—2 ¾ inch wide strips
