

Quilt As You Go – Machine Class

If you have ever wondered about how to quilt your own projects but felt unsure about where to start, this class is designed for you. We will explore and create samples using several different techniques, giving you a clear understanding of your available options for quilting as you go, including how to attach quilted blocks to each other!



Skill Level: All - Must have a basic understanding of your machine and quilting tools/terminology.

Kit Fee: \$15 includes batting, backing and fabric for samples (if you have scrapes of fabric or 2.5 inch jelly roll scrapes you may choose to bring them)

Supply List: Sewing machine in good working condition (with an even feed foot if possible). White thread for bobbin and quilting along with your basic sewing kit of rotary cutter (with new blade) and small cutting mat, scissors, pins and a ruler for squaring up your blocks.
